

Leahurst Research Grant

The Leahurst Research Grant supports nursing and midwifery research undertaken in South Australia that may also extend to a national level.

The research objective must be to improve a specific area of nursing or midwifery practice and should demonstrate how this will be achieved.

Funding available for research is up to \$30,000 to be conducted over a maximum of 2 years.

Applications are due by 30th June each year.

Please read the terms and conditions and prepare applications according to the checklist provided.



Leahurst Research Grant Terms and Conditions

- The Chief Investigator is an AHPRA registered nurse or midwife.
- The Chief Investigator has a PhD qualification.
- The focus of the proposed research relates to nursing or midwifery practice or education.
- The due date for an application is 30th June in any given year.
- One copy of the application including the Chief Investigator's CV and the completed checklist is to be emailed as an attachment to: SamanthaCreten@deannewbery.com.au
- The decision to award or not award a grant is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- Applicants will be notified by 31st August in the year of the application via email.
- The Foundation reserves the right to not award a research grant in any given year.
- Research is to be undertaken in South Australia within 1-2 years.
- Funding available is up to a total of AUS\$30,000.
- Funding is to be administered by the organisation or the educational institution of the Chief Investigator.
- Reporting Midterm and Final Reports are required to receive further funds.
 These reports should include the progress and research activities to date. It is
 the responsibility of the Chief Investigator to submit reports on time to the
 email above.
- Funds: 40% is granted on approval, 50% on receipt of a Midterm Report due at the halfway mark, and 10% on receipt of the Final Report due one month prior to the completion of the project.
- Acknowledgement of Leahurst Nurses' Foundation Inc. is required in all presentations and publications. The logo can be provided on request.
- It is expected the Chief Investigator will do a presentation to the Leahurst Board within six months of completion of the research and provide a copy of any resultant publications to the Leahurst Nurses' Foundation Inc.
- A synopsis is to be provided of the completed research that will be posted on the Leahurst Nurses' Foundation Inc website.
